Temporary Position

The wellbeing of our students and staff is at the centre of everything we do which is why the position of School Nurse is so important to us. Waverley College invites applications for a temporary part time nurse to start in November 2023 until end August 2024, on Thursdays and Fridays.

This is a terrific role for a Registered Nurse which manages the health of students as well as our staff and visitors when required. The role works within our beautifully appointed Health Centre, co-located with other health professionals. Here, you will provide direct primary healthcare and first aid to students and staff, and facilitate the day to day operation of the Health Centre. To be successful, you will need the following:

- Current registration certified by AHPRA
- Annual assessment and certification of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Current NSW Working with Children Check
- Recent Triage or First Aid experience

Ideally, you would have experience working in a similar role, but this is not essential. You should have the ability to collect and record accurate medical data, be able to work independently, and possess competent IT skills. You should also be supportive of the Catholic ethos of the community. Waverley College is a Catholic school in the Edmund Rice tradition.
