Educational Access Schemes

- FINANCIAL HARDSHIP - FO1K to include:
 - Jobkeeper
 - COVID-19 Disaster
 - Jobsaver
 - Pandemic leave
- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA - parent/s, guardian/s received payment for at least 3 months. The 3 months can come from a single payment type or a combination of payment types.
- FO1K is a single disadvantage - will only be considered once for this EAS disadvantage code.
- EAS applications & documents must be submitted by Friday 17 December to receive an eligibility letter on Thursday 20 January 2022.

Early Entry offers - what to tell students

- Accept all offers (direct & via UAC) – can receive 1 unconditional offer per UAC offer round
- UTS, WSU & Macquarie may have students accept & enrol as a one step process.
- Remove all offered & accepted courses UAC preference list (to free up other courses to be considered in future rounds)
- If a student changes their mind about an already accepted/enrolled course – they **MUST** withdraw formally from that course, so not to receive academic & financial penalty by Census Date (check each uni)

Unique Student Identifier **USI**

- A **USI** is your individual education identifier for life & online record of your training attainments in Australia.
- You'll need a **USI** in order to receive commonwealth financial assistance (ie HECS) & to obtain your qualification or statement of attainment.
- You create it once & there's no cost. Visit www.usi.gov.au
- You must enter a **USI** as part of the enrolment requirements

Top Tips for students

- Don't lose sight of your goals.
- Make should you leave your options open and explore all course possibilities.
- Make sure your preferences are in order you'd like them considered
- Track the closing dates
- Remember the ATAR is only one pathway into university
